- Day 1** Transpacific flight with Japan Airlines to Tokyo.
- Day 2** Arrival in Tokyo. Transfer to hotel with scheduled hotel limousine bus service. Evening at leisure.
- Day 3** Full day city tour to include the Meiji Shinto Shrine - Japan's most famous Shinto shrine, Akasaka Guest House, The National Diet Building - the Japanese Parliament, the Imperial Palace East Garden, Asakusa Kannon Temple and Nakamise Shopping Street - The oldest and most popular temple in Tokyo, as well as a fifty-minute cruise around Tokyo Bay, a visit to Rainbow Bridge and the nearby futuristic city of Odaiba, and Japan's world renowned Ginza Shopping District. **(Buffet Breakfast, Lunch)**
- Day 4** Morning departure from Tokyo by Shinkansen (Bullet Train) to Atami - one of the most flourishing spa resorts in Japan, famous for its "Million-dollar Night View." Transfer to hotel by taxi. Overnight in a traditional Japanese Ryokan. Evening at leisure to relax and enjoy the natural hot springs. **(Buffet Breakfast, Dinner)**
- Day 5** Morning at leisure to explore Atami. Afternoon departure by Shinkansen to Tokyo. **(Buffet Breakfast)**
- Day 6** Morning visit to a traditional Sumo Amphitheatre "Kokugikan" and Sumo Museum with a collection of artefacts dating right back to the Edo period. In the afternoon you can enjoy a Dohyo-iri (entering the ring) ceremony and some exciting Sumo matches. English guidance by rental radio is available. **(Buffet Breakfast)**
- Day 7** Full day sightseeing to include: Shiodome - one of the most celebrated newly developed areas in Tokyo - with many fashionable shops and restaurants, Hama-Rikyu Garden - where you can enjoy a stroll in the scenic and historic Japanese Garden of the Tokugawa Shogunate, Tsukiji Market - a bustling Tokyo market where you can taste some of the best sushi at a fraction of the regular price, Namiyoke Inari Shrine - a colorful Shinto shrine, and the Edo Tokyo Museum - for a hands-on experience of Tokyo's past with the re-creation of old Edo and post-Meiji Tokyo in this massive, futuristic building. **(Buffet Breakfast)**
- Day 8** Morning departure by train to Kamakura. Full day sight seeing to include: the Great Buddha - a bronze image measuring 11.4 meters in height at Kotokuin Temple, Hase Kannon Temple - with its gilt statue of Kannon. Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine - a symbol of the first great Shogun Minamoto, featuring an arched bridge, the Genji and Heike ponds, a huge Gingko tree, and the colorful Main Hall standing at the top of 62 stone steps. **(Buffet Breakfast)**
- Day 9** Full day at leisure. **(Buffet Breakfast)**
- Day 10** Morning at leisure. Afternoon transfer to airport for homebound flights. **(Buffet Breakfast)**
